This refers to your correspondence to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, National Firearms Act Branch, which was forwarded to the Firearms Technology Industry Services Branch (FTISB) on September 18, 2016. Specifically you inquire about whether a combination of parts designed to attach a SIG SB-15 Pistol Stabilizing Brace to a Glock pistol, would result in the firearm being classified a “firearm” under the National Firearms Act (NFA).

To make an authoritative determination regarding the status of your proposed pistol configuration in accordance with Federal firearms statutes, we must have an actual sample to examine.

If you manufacture and submit this item to FTISB and we determine that it is not regulated by Federal firearms laws, we will make every effort to return the item to you as soon as possible. We caution that you will be responsible for the shipping costs required for its return. Also, we cannot guarantee that the device will not be damaged or destroyed during the evaluation process. If you would like to submit the item, please ship to our address (providing a FEDEX or similar prepaid shipping label for return shipping).
