Dear Ms. Wolfe:

Pursuant to F.R.A.P. 28(j), amicus curiae Everytown for Gun Safety writes to notify this Court of supplemental authority supporting the constitutionality of the restrictions on firearms in parks in New York's Concealed Carry Improvement Act ("CCIA"). In its amicus brief, Everytown pointed to 66 individual historical restrictions on firearms in parks and a compilation of federal restrictions. *See* Dkt. 193 (No. 22-2908) at 26 n.21 (linking to website). Everytown has since identified 53 additional examples and sources. We attach the full list as Exhibit A, with newly identified restrictions and sources highlighted.

Although Everytown attorneys have focused on locating parks restrictions specifically, this research has taken considerable time. Historical research is a slow and cumulative process. *See id.* at 21-22; *see also, e.g.*, Antonin Scalia, *Originalism: The*

Lesser Evil, 57 U. Cin. L. Rev. 849, 856-57, 861 (1989) (stating that, when "[p]roperly done," the "often exceedingly difficult" task of "plumb[ing] the original understanding of an ancient text" requires, among other things, "consideration of an enormous mass of material").

Even without these supplemental examples, the historical record robustly demonstrates that the CCIA's restriction is constitutional. *See, e.g.*, Everytown Br. 22 n.17, 26. Because, however, the "job of judges is not to resolve historical questions in the abstract," *N.Y. State Rifle & Pistol Ass'n v. Bruen*, 142 S. Ct. 2111, 2130 n.6 (2022), Everytown respectfully submits that a more developed historical record will only aid this Court's inquiry.
