ORDER

This matter came before the Court upon (1) Defendant's Motion to Dissolve Injunction (the "Dissolution Motion") and (2) Plaintiffs' Motion for a Rule to Show Cause for Violation of this Court's Final Order (the "Show Cause Motion").

The parties appeared before the Court on June 3, 2026, and the Court heard argument on the Dissolution Motion and the Show Cause Motion. Having considered the briefs and arguments of the parties, and for the reasons set forth by the Court on the record, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Dissolution Motion is **DENIED** at this time, with further briefing and argument to proceed as to its final disposition as set forth below.
2. The Show Cause Motion is **DENIED**, without prejudice to any party wishing to

seek further relief should any violation of the permanent injunction contained within the Court's October 29, 2025 Final Order (the "Injunction Order") occur.

3. The Court's Injunction Order remains in effect unless and until it is dissolved by further order of this Court. The Virginia Department of State Police, and all law enforcement divisions, agencies, and officers within the Commonwealth, to include their successors or replacements in office, shall continue to abide by the Injunction Order unless and until it is dissolved by this Court, and remain enjoined and prohibited from administering, enforcing, or otherwise imposing upon any person the requirements of, the Act (Va. Code § 18.2-308.2:5) at this time.

4. On or before June 15, 2026, the parties shall file supplemental briefs on the issues directed by the Court at the June 3, 2026 hearing.


5. Counsel for the parties are directed to confer and contact the Court to schedule a hearing on this matter to be held prior to July 1, 2026 or as soon thereafter as practicable.
